The Friends of Pagham Harbour (FoPH) was formed in 1974 to support the Pagham Harbour Local Nature Reserve, its conservation, education and research roles as well as the management of the Reserve.

FoPH Activities

FoPH is an independent charity working for the benefit of the public. It uses its subscriptions, donations and other income to help fund wildlife surveys, purchases of equipments, the construction of hides for bird-watching, support educational activities and other projects related to the Pagham Harbour Local Nature Reserve. FoPH cooperates closely with the Reserve management.

Volunteering opportunities

Members can participate in many activities at the Reserve throughout the year. A wide variety of conservation and maintenance tasks need doing: tree-planting, coppicing, reed-bed management, rhododendron removal and so on. Necessary equipment and training are provided.

Volunteers can join in research tasks e.g. surveying various invertebrate populations, the distribution of water voles, hedgerows and other vegetation. A number of rare species, new to the Reserve, have been identified.

Other important areas where the Friends are involved include devising and running events such as open-days and helping during school educational visits.

Stewards for the Visitor Centre are always needed as the Centre is open daily. Stewards sell books and maps, etc, and provide information to visitors. Reserve staff are always available to answer any complicated questions so no particular expertise is required.
